



St Mary's R.C. Primary School School Rules Policy

1. Courtesy, good manners and respect is expected at all times, from everyone.
2. All children must line-up in the playground at the beginning of the day and when the bell goes at the end of playtime, waiting quietly and calmly in lines.
3. Children come into school quietly and orderly and hang up their coats / bag.
4. Children go straight into class, quietly.
 - KS1 children sit on the carpet
 - KS2 children sit down in their places and complete directed activity.
5. Running, shouting etc. is not allowed in school.
6. In class no child is allowed to disturb or distract other children with the intention of preventing learning. Children and adults must look and listen to each other when they are speaking with one another.
7. In lessons children must put up their hand and wait for teacher to ask them to speak. Calling out is not permitted.
8. All children go outside at play-time, unless they have permission to stay inside.
9. All children stay in their own play-ground KS1 or KS2, unless given permission to do otherwise.
10. Any form of fighting (even play fighting), kicking, punching, spitting is not allowed.

11. Sweets and drinks are not allowed, with the exception of water, which is encouraged and should be bought into school in a labelled bottle.
12. Toys are not allowed, unless given permission. Children are not allowed to bring balls in to school.
13. Bad language of any kind is not tolerated. This may lead to one day's exclusion.
14. Children are not allowed to wear jewellery in school except for a wrist watch or small stud earrings.
15. Children are not allowed to wear nail varnish in school.
16. Children must change for P.E. (shorts, T-shirt, plimsolls).
17. Children must stand aside in the corridor for all adults.
18. Children are expected to wear school uniform and sensible footwear.
19. An explanatory note or phone call to the office must be sent from home if a child is absent, or has to miss P.E. or Swimming.
20. Children must complete the homework set for them, and parents are encouraged to support their child to work independently.
21. Extreme haircuts are not allowed e.g. shaving with lines. Children with long hair which is longer than collar length must have it tied back whilst they are in school.
22. Children are not allowed to play with footballs or balls in the yard, before and after school
23. St. Mary's is a non-smoking school.
24. Parents/carers or children are not allowed to bring dogs onto the premises unless they are carried.
25. Teachers accept responsibility for children on the Adventure trail only during school hours.(8.55 - 3.20). Children should not go on the tyres or Adventure trail before or after school.
